## Calculating summary scores for the FS-ICU 24R

Three summary scores can be derived from the FS-ICU 24R questionnaire. The satisfaction with care summary score is derived from the questions numbered 1 through 14 (which consists of 16 questions because question 2 has parts $\mathrm{a}, \mathrm{b}$ and c ). The satisfaction with decision making summary score is derived from questions 15 through 24 ( 10 questions). The overall satisfaction score is derived from questions 1 through 24 ( 26 questions). The following 4 steps can be used to calculate the three summary scores.

STEP 1: Verify all questions are coded as integers from 1 (worst) to 5 (best); any other responses should be corrected or set to missing.
STEP 2: For each of the three summary scores, calculate the average of the responses for the questions belonging to that summary score (see above).
STEP 3: Set summary scores to missing if more than $30 \%$ of the items contributing to the score are missing. Specifically, Satisfaction with care is set to missing if 5 or more questions are missing, satisfaction with decision making is set to missing if 4 or more questions are missing, and the overall satisfaction score is set to missing if 8 or more of the 26 questions are missing.
STEP 4: Rescale the summary scores from 1 through 5 to 0 through 100 by subtracting 1 from the scores (so they can range from 0 to 4 ) and then multiplying each score by 25.
